The Shicuo Bikeway in Mailiao Township connects to Yunlin's 154 Tourism Corridor, Lunbei Ecological and Recreational Bikeway, and Qikan and Zhaoan Hakka Bikeway, linking up Xiluo and Linnei, and following the south bank of the Zhuoshui River. Along the way are ever-changing panoramas from the seaside to the mountains. The end of the Zhuoxi South Bank Bikeway is Linnei Station. Experience idyllic scenery and locally produced fruits and vegetables.



Mailiao Gongfan Temple

This is where Kaishan Mazu is worshipped and is an important spiritual center along Yunlin's coast.



Zhao'an Hakka Culture Center

Lunbei, Erlun and Xiluo Town are the areas with the largest Hakka distribution in Zhao'an. This museum preserves and passes on Hakka culture and traditions.



Chan-Chau-Ku Happy Moo Ranch

Cow-themed art installations can be found all around the park to connect with local farming activities.



Erlun Story House

The Erlun patrol station was the earliest patrol station set up during the Japanese colonial era (1895-1945) in Yunlin County.



Xiluo Yanping Old Street

The shophouse is evidence of commercial and industrial activities during the Japanese colonial era.



Xiluo Fuxing Temple

Tianshang Shengmu is the oldest Mazu Temple in the Zhuoshui River basin. The main worship of the Tianshang shengmu, known as the Mazu Temple.



The East Market

East Market is the earliest market in Xiluo. In 2007, it was converted into a creative and cultural industries market, which led to its revival.



Rinnai Station

Erected in 1907, this was the first train station built beyond the Zhuoshui River.



The journey begins along the 1-5 southern Taiwan coastal branch, passing Mailiao Gongfan Temple and Taixi Seaside Park, before connecting to the unique Black Forest Bikeway along the coast. Then, it heads to Santiaolun Beach before reaching the Yiwu Flood Detention Pond, which is comparable to Sun Moon Lake, and Chenglong Wetlands. Along the way, experience the pure and natural landscapes of Yunlin's coastal communities. The Password to Unlocking True Love Bikeway is the starting point for Kouhu's classic small-town bikeway and includes beautiful wetlands and coastal scenery.



Jinmuyuan Pulp Art Village

Within this park are installations by master paper artist Lin Jin-Shan.



Sanjoron Beach Water Park

Due to its geographical location, the beach at Santiaolun has plenty of wind and calm waters, making it a suitable site for kiteboarding.



Black Forest Bikeway

Originally an ox cart trail, on both sides have been planted beef wood trees that serve as windbreakers.



Hakuziliao Oh Bear Art Village

Eastern myths are depicted in a humorous and creative style using local elements.

Cultural Tour of Beigang

From the Chaotian Temple, the spiritual center of Yunlin, travel along Taiwan's only religious-themed bikeway. Pass famous attractions such as the monument to Yan Si-Qi, Shuilin Yan Si-Qi Storyhouse, Kouhu Visitor Center, Yiwu Detention Basin, and Chenglong Wetlands and enjoy Yunlin's coastal scenery and beautiful architecture. The bikeway passes through classic towns: Beigang Town bikeway recommended scenic spots, among which Shizhai in Shuilin Township is a camp built by the han who came to Taiwan for reclamation to defend against foreign enemies. Come and experience the classic historical bicycle tour of Beigang Town!

Fried Pan Kueh, Men Sheng Fu, Yuanzi Soup, Duck soup

Must-eat food in Kouhu Township:
Mullet roe, Grouper, Virgin squid, Sea bream

Shuizhen Greenway, the Zhuoshui River Trunk Line of the Jianan Canal

Close-up Views of Canals and Fields

41.8km /2.3hrs.



The axis line of the national greenway is the first bikeway in Taiwan along an irrigation canal. The starting point is the Farmland Water Conservancy Cultural Relics Exhibition Hall in Linnei. Gorgeous deciduous cypress trees and the well-known Bagua Pond can be found along this 42-kilometer bikeway, which links Linnei, Citong, Huwei, Tuku, and Yuanzhang, before crossing the Beigang River and joining the north trunk line in Chiayi. The Shuizhen Greenway is a bikeway that passes the Shiliu, Dounan, and Shigui stations. It is a must-visit for railway enthusiasts.



Farmland Water Conservancy Cultural Relics Exhibition Hall
This is the first exhibition hall in Taiwan devoted to water conservancy.



Next Land
This is a venue for fun, creativity, culture, production area visits, and lectures.



Tianyifude Temple
This classic temple is devoted to Fude Zhengshen, also known as the land god.



Shihliu Station
Built a century ago during the Japanese colonial era, it is the only remaining Japanese-style wooden station in Yunlin County.

Understanding Traditional Religious Sites

"Welcoming Mazu in March" is one of the biggest annual religious events in Taiwan. The parade commences at Fuxing Temple in Shiluo and passes the Tianhou Temple in Huwei and Shuntian Temple in Tuku, before ending at Chaotian Temple in Beigang. This bikeway route makes it possible to follow Mazu's path any time of the year and experience traditional culture and local hospitality. Along the Riding with Deities cycling route pass through the classic small town of Huwei. Experience traditional religious beliefs and culture and enjoy great food at the Huwei Sugar Factory.

Sugar Factory Ice Products, Charcoal Roast Duck Cake, Squid Noodle Soup


Recommended attractions in the classic town of Douliu in 2021

This historic wood building served as a police dormitory during the Japanese colonial era.




Douliu Gukeng Green Sports and Leisure Bikeway


Challenging Yundong, Highway 3 Forest Route

Exciting Round-the-Mountain Route

The Highway 3 Forest Route is challenging and connects the Douliu City center, Gukeng green tunnel, Huashan Literature Trail, and Hebaoshan Tonghua Park. This 53 kilometer routes takes you away from the city into places of nature and quiet, and is suitable for training or recreational cycling. The Challenging Yundong Bikeway passes through two classic small towns, Douliu City and Gukeng Township, which make great rest stops.

Shuttle service for trains and THSR (Visit the "Transportation & Transfers" for information.)

- Restrictions for carrying bicycles on board TRA and THSR trains:
length must not exceed 150 cm; the sum of the length, width, and height must not exceed 220 cm; and the total weight must not exceed 40 kg. Do not place in plastic or cloth bag or other type of packaging.
- Bicycle check-in service is available at the following train stations:
Rinnai, Douliu, Dounan
- See TRA and THSR regulations for fares.

Traveling with a bicycle

- Express Trains:**
Cars have dedicated frames for bicycles.
- Non-Express Trains:**
Riders must keep their bicycle with them but avoid obstructing other passengers.

Use of bicycle carrying bag

Fold or disassemble your bicycle and pack into a bag that can be carried onto the train.
